There was a continued conversation with questions and comments by the Planning Commission on the A-27 Non-conforming Code Update in addition to other comments brought up by the public during testimony which were answered by Ms. Arai. Ms. Arai read an emailed comment from the Department of Fish & Wildlife to the Planning Commission. A discussion ensued. Questions generally included topics related to the use of best available science, an explanation and clarification of terms used for the section on functional isolation, and background information on the two-year timeframe for reconstruction / replacement of a nonconforming structure that has been destroyed. Ms. Arai will be looking at the functional isolation section of the Code Update in particular. The Planning Commission requested more time to review and discuss before making a recommendation.
