## **Continued Business** 1 2 6:45 P.M. WORK SESSION: OLYMPIA JOINT PLAN 3 5. (Thurston County Staff: Leah Davis, Maya Teeple; City of Olympia Staff: Joyce Phillips) 4 5 Staff provided an introduction, overview, and background of the updated version of the 6 Olympia Joint Plan to Thurston County and City of Olympia Planning Commissioners. 7 8 Ms. Davis provided a comparison of substantive differences between the 2004 version of 9 the Joint Plan and the current proposed update to include changes. Discussion ensued. 10 11 There was a commissioner request for maps of each of the UGA areas for comparison to 12 be provided for the public review for the public hearing. 13 14 There was a commissioner request for better clarification in the Joint Plan as to how the 15 County sees the UGA areas and zoning versus how the City views them. There was a 16 question on the priorities of the annexation of those areas. Staff are unaware of any formal 17 plans for annexation, but the City of Olympia will check into it. There was a request for 18 text to be added in the introduction with additional context. 19 20 Several Commissioners have requested that a descriptive narrative be added of the different 21 UGAs around the City of Olympia and how the City envisions them to be moving forward 22 during this next 20-year period. This is to include those areas that were identified in the 23 northwest sector that may be challenging to provide city sewer and the City's vision for 24 that. Staff will create maps and provide narrative. 25 26 MOTION: Commissioner Karman moved to set a public hearing for Comprehensive 27 Plan Amendment Docket Item CPA-1, the Olympia Joint Plan, for Wednesday, 28 November 30, 2022 at 7:00 pm or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. 29 Commissioner Halverson seconded.
