

Thurston County

Veterans Assistance Program

The assistance program is an emergency fund to assist veterans with basic living expenses. There is an income limit per household of up to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level. The veteran must have an “honorable” discharge or “general under honorable conditions” characterization of service for a medical reason and have served at least 180 days of active-duty service, excluding training. Additional requirements include being a Washington state resident for at least 6 months and living in Thurston County for at least 31 days immediately prior to the application date. Assistance is provided as a single, non-recurring payment.

In addition to a signed application, the following documents are required:

Required For Everyone

- ☐ DD 214, COPY 2 or 4 or NGB 22
- ☐ State Issued Identification
- ☐ Residency Verification – WA ID or Utility Bill
- ☐ Proof of DSHS Benefits, if applicable (TANF/Food Stamps)
- ☐ Marriage Certificate, if applicable
- ☐ Death Certificate (if the Veteran is deceased)
- ☐ Birth certificate for all children **17 and under** in the home, if applicable
- ☐ Proof of income for **ALL** adults in the home for the **previous 31 days**
(check stubs, cash app, child support, social security, VA disability, etc.)
- ☐ Zero Income Affidavit (for any adult in the home that states they have zero income)
- ☐ **ALL** banking statements for **ALL** adults in the home for the **last 2 months**
(checking, savings, Direct Express, etc.)

PLUS if you are requesting:

Rental Assistance

- ☐ Current Lease
- ☐ Current Rent Statement or Pay/Vacate Notice

Mortgage Assistance

- ☐ Current Mortgage Statement

Move-in Cost Assistance

- ☐ Intent to Rent Letter

Utility Assistance

- ☐ Current Utility Bill

Car Repair Assistance

- ☐ Car Title or Registration
- ☐ Current Valid Car Insurance
- ☐ Two Quotes from Thurston County Licensed Mechanics
