6. 7:03 PM WORK SESSION #2: CPA-1, THE CITY OF YELM & THURSTON COUNTY JOINT PLAN RECCOMENDATION.

Ms. Schwartz presented updated information regarding the Yelm Joint Plan. The information provided answered previous questions the Commissioners had, as well as a review of the public comments received. Chair Perez asked if Map 1a would be included in the draft plan. Commissioner Wheatley commented most citizens recognize an aerial map. All Commissioners agree to include Map 1a.

Commissioner Wheatley is concerned with the new legislation on climate change. Ms. Schwartz answered that climate change will be addressed in the Thurston 2045 Comprehensive Plan. Commissioner Wheatley asked if the City of Yelm would be addressing that in their Comprehensive Plan Update. Mr. Cooper replied that they hired a consultant to help with the Yelm 2045 update, which helps review all new legislation for addition to the City of Yelm's Comprehensive Plan Update. Mr. Cooper goes on to explain that the City of Yelm has recently completed a habitat conservation plan. The City of Yelm will change some of its permitting processes as well as make sure that pocket gopher's habitat is conserved. By doing this, The City would have more open space.

Commissioner Wheatley suggested adding a part of a public comment which describes agricultural land outside of the Yelm UGA. The rest of the commissions agreed on the addition. Commissioner Pestinger is concerned with water and housing. His concern with the language surrounding housing is there is nothing in the plan that states there will be diversified or affordable housing. Mr. Cooper states that the City of Yelm just adopted a housing action plan which establishes the goals and strategies for a diversity of housing. The City of Yelm has consulted other cities within the county to build a process to allocate the different levels of housing. Commissioner Pestinger asked about water resources for housing. The City of Yelm has water rights up to 2036 and approximately 6-7,000 new resident dwellings.

MOTION: Commissioner Simmons moved to approve the City of Yelm and Thurston County Joint Plan update by a full repeal and replace.

Motion was carried unanimously.
